BOARDING FEES

The annual boarding fee for Al Jamiatul Islamiyyah is £2,950, We expect Parents to pay the fees in three instalments. We do stress that the fees must be paid promptly, any delay may lead to suspension or exclusion of the student from the school.

COMMUTING FEE

The annual commuting fee for Al Jamiatul Islamiyyah is £1,650. We expect Parents to pay the fees in two instalments. We do stress that the fees must be paid promptly, any delay may lead to suspension or exclusion of the student from the school.

NOTE- There is a one off Administration Charge of £250 for boarding students and £125 Administration Charge for commuting students on day of enrolment

SECTION 7: RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Disclosure of all previous character and conduct is necessary. The application will be rejected if any information is given falsely.
2. Whilst in Darul Uloom students must attend all lessons & examinations. No student is allowed to leave Darul Uloom premises during Darul Uloom hours (8:15am-7.30pm weekdays and 8:15am -1 pm on Saturday), however, permission may be given in case of an emergency or necessity. Parents or guardians wishing to obtain leave for student must contact the Pastoral care team.
3. Students have to follow Islamic Laws and regulations in all aspects of their life. Students who break the spirit of the rules will be cautioned and the school retains the sole right to expel or exclude students who breach rules on a regular basis. There will be no recourse from expulsion except at the discretion of the school. The school's decision in such cases will be final and students will have no legal remedy against expulsion in such cases.
4. The Darul Uloom maintains strict adherence to basic Islamic principles of good conduct, behaviour and respect. Above all, students are expected to respect Teachers, Staff members and fellow students. Any student found guilty of insulting the Teachers, Staff members or fellow students of Darul Uloom will be judged as inexcusable and will be dismissed or suspended.
5. If any student wants to leave the Darul Uloom, has to notify the office at least 3 months before. All due fees must be cleared prior to leave.
6. Darul Uloom expects students to aspire to academic excellence in Islamic and National Curriculum subjects. Students are expected to observe and act upon the lesson timetables.

Rules of the School

1. All students are expected to wear white jubbah or white shalwar kameez with a white topee and the Darul Uloom cardigan.
2. Students are expected to be punctual in offering five daily prayers and must be present in the Masjid 10 minutes before each prayer.
3. Students must participate in all curricular and extra-curricular activities assigned by the teachers.
4. Class rooms and Darul Uloom premises must be kept clean by the students. Should a student cause any damage to the Darul Uloom or others property, parents or guardians are to be responsible for compensation including full costs of repair or replacement.
5. The student is to maintain his hair accordingly to Islamic Customs and in equal length. Beard should not be shaved or trimmed before it reaches the length of a fist.
6. The use of mobile phones is not allowed on the Darul Uloom premises.
7. Smoking, stealing, missing prayers are strictly against the spirit of the Darul Uloom rules and are deemed to be grounds for expulsion.
8. Any student leaving the premises, even for a short period of time, must notify the supervisor or teacher concerned. Any student going outside Darul Uloom premises without authorized permission will be cautioned.
9. Unauthorized absence and continuous late coming may lead to expulsion from the Darul Uloom.
10. Students are to examine and observe the rules of the school. A copy of the booklet explaining full rules will be made available to each student on admission.

GCSE Policy: Darul Uloom reserves the right to withdraw any student from the GCSE examinations if the student found to be incapable of obtaining a pass, based on internal assessment by DU. Opportunities to arrange alternative qualifications will be provided.

Darul Uloom reserves the full right to alter, add to or amend the rules and regulations as and when necessary.
